## Dear Parents,

As you know the situation with the Coronavirus pandemic is escalating continuously and we are working hard to ensure the safety of all the members of our school wide community, whilst continuing to provide the highest quality education under the challenging circumstances.

We are writing to inform you of our plans to ensure a smooth continuation of your child's education, given our pre schools are now forced to close from **6pm** on **Friday 20th March 2020**.

We strive day by day to provide our children the most caring, exciting and innovative education. We do understand the enormous impact school closure will have on delivering this, and we have worked tirelessly to devise plane that will ensure a smooth continuation of your child's early years education.

We have set work for your children across all seven areas of learning and development detailed with their early years curriculum. This includes songs, stories and sensory play for our babies, comprehensive jolly phonics and mathematical activities linked to various topics and differentiated according to our different age groups.

We will reopen as soon as the government allows us, in order to continue to provide an outstanding environment for your children to learn, discover and make friends whilst having fun and celebrating success all the way.
